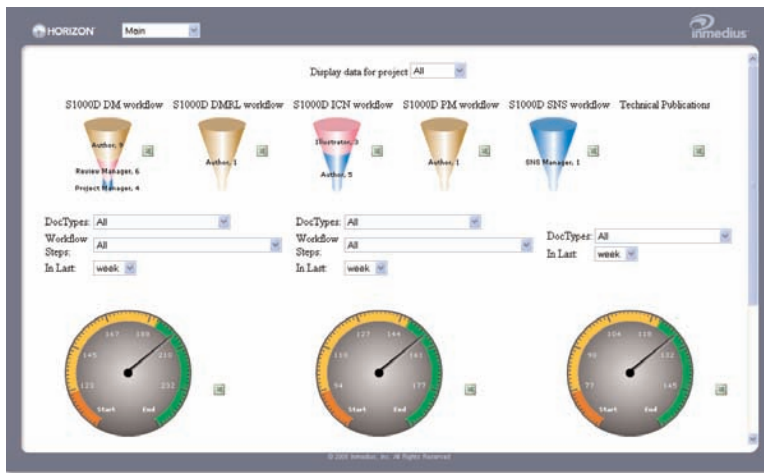
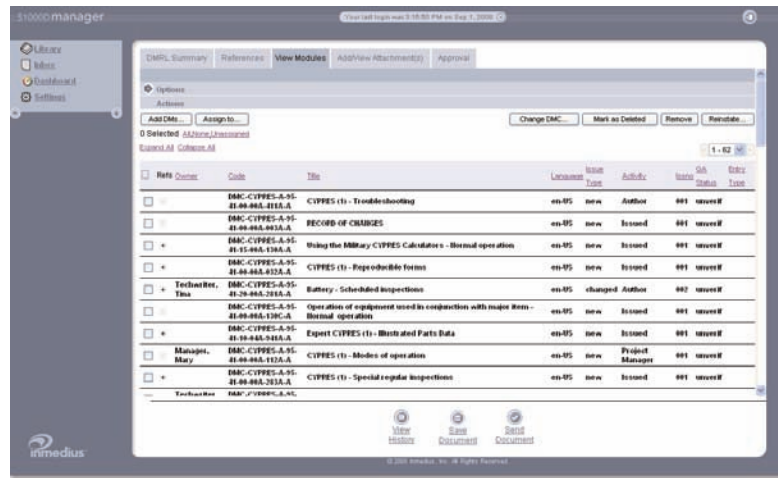


DMRL Managed as Documents

As XML documents with a lifecycle, Data Module Requirements Lists (DMRL) are managed as separate documents. DMRL may be checked out, issued, approved and have their own workflow.

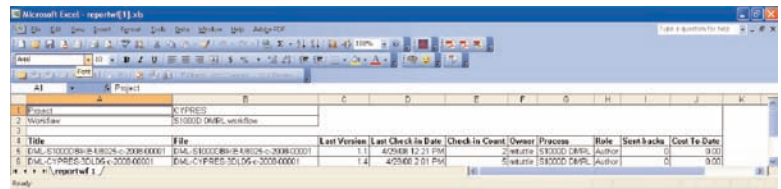


Centralized Dashboard Control Center

The new centralized Inmedius Dashboard provides complete transparency and a visual representation of the S1000D technical documentation process. Other Enhancements

- All Modules may be created through the project view.
- When creating a new Illustrated Control Number (ICN), users can upload one file to become the initial graphic content.
- Existing ICNs may be added to DM references
- Existing Data Module Codes (DMCs) may be added to a DMRL as references
